He worked with it for 22 years before talking retirement in 2006. Among others, both Dr Alauddin and his wife, Fatema Alauddin are founder members of UAP. As professionals in and promoters of education, they have established SN Academy for children to give them good foundation in elementary education in their rural area at Jhawail in Gopulpur Upazila of Tangail district.

Dr. Alauddin is an author of a text book, "Samajik Gabaysana: Baigyanik Gyan Onneswan Padhati" published by the Textbook Division of Bangla Academy. Dr. Alauddin had the opportunity of providing training consultancy

He holds the degrees of a Master's and bachelor's in Metallurgical Engineering from Bangladesh University of Science and Technology (BUET).
